

An undivided 1/3 interest in shaft No.1 and shaft No.2 has been credited to the Eldorado, Eldorado No.2 and Wild Horse lodes. These shafts have been sunk with a view to the most intelligent, economical and advantageous development of the property. The ground rises rapidly from shaft No.1 to Cor.No.3 of the Wild Horse lode and from shaft No.2 to Cor.No.3 of the Eldorado No.2 lode, and drifts run from these shafts to the respective claims would crosscut the vein formation and attain a considerable depth.

INSTRUMENT.

This survey was made with a Berger & Son transit. The courses were deflected from the true meridian as determined by a direct solar observation. The distances were measured with a five hundred foot steel tape.
