This survey was made with a Brandis Sons and Co. Light Mountain Transit.

The courses were deflected from a true meridian as determined by direct solar observation on the sun. The distances were measured with 660 ft, and 100 ft. steel tapes.

REPORT.

The S.E. Cor, of Sec, 32 T. 5 S, R 40 E, to which tie is given, is a porphyry stone, showing above ground 14x10 x9 ins, in mound of stone, marked 11 on W, side, and 1111 on E, side.
