

Survey No. 3571
Two Ladies Lode

- Instrument -

This Survey was made with a Gurley Light Mountain Transit. The Courses were deflected from the true Meridian as determined by me by direct Solar observations. The distances were measured with 100 ft. and 300 ft. steel tapes.

- Report -

The N. W. Cor. of Sec. 26. T23 N. R. 62 E of the Mt. Diablo Base and Meridian, is a quartzite rock, 18x9x9 ins. with two (2) notches on the South, and two (2) notches on the East, sides, with rock monument.

This is the nearest known corner of the Public Land Survey.

Cor. No. 1, Sur. No. 2503, Little Johnny Mining Claim Lode, which is identical with Cor. No. 3 Sur. No. 3561, Wild West Mine Lode, is a pine post 5 ins. square, standing 2 1/2 ft. above ground with mound of stone, Scribed 1-2503 and 3-3561

Cor. No. 2, Sur. No. 2503, Little Johnny Mining Claim Lode, is a pine post 6 ins. square standing 2 ft. high in mound of stone Scribed 2-2503

Cor. No. 1 Sur. No. 2503, Last Chance Mining Claim Lode, is a pine post 4 ins. square, 2 1/2 ft. above ground in a mound of stone, Scribed 1-2503
