Cor. No. 4, S.M. No. 2387, Badie No. 2 lode, lev. No. 4, S.M. No. 2387 Gipsy King lode, Cor. No. 1, S.M. No. 2387 Gipsy King lode and Cor. No. 2, S.M. No. 2387 Gipsy Queen lode are all unpainted pine posts 4x4 ins., showing 3 ft. above ground and mound of stone and earth, and scribed with the proper corner and survey numbers. The lode claims of which these posts are the corners were determined by running the side lines of the lodes and finding some corners bearing the names of the lodes.

Cor. No. 3, S.M. No. 2387, Badie No. 2 lode is on surface of rhyolite ledge just above general surface of the ground and dimly chiseled 3-2387. The position of the cross, if there is one, could not be determined.

S.M. lev. of Sec. 25 of T. 3 N., R. 42 E., M. 2. B. and M. is a rhyolite stone 10x14x16 ins., set on ground in mound of stone and chiseled with a x on its top and 1 on east and 1 on south side.

The $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. Cor. on west side of Sec. 25 of T. 3 N., R. 42 E., M. 2. B. and M. is a porphyry stone 8x12x14 ins., set in ground and chiseled $\frac{1}{4}$ on east side.

The $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. lev. on south line of Sec. 25 of T. 3 N., R. 42 E. is a rhyolite stone 5x12x16 ins., set in ground by mound of rock and chiseled $\frac{1}{4}$ on south side.

West side post of location of Reptile lode is a pine post 4x4 ins., painted white, showing 3 ft. above ground and mound of stone and earth, and marked "West side centre Reptile lode".
