INSTRUMENT.

This survey was made with a Buff and Buff light mountain transit. The courses were deflected from the true meridian as determined by direct solar observation. The distances were measured with 100 and 650 ft. steel tapes.

REPORT.

The Cor. to Secs. 12 and 13, T. 25, S. R. 57 E. and to Secs. 7 and 18, T. 25, S. R. 58 E. Mt. Diablo B. and M. is a 8" x 14" Limestone rock, extending 2 ft. above a mound of stone, marked with two (2) notches on north, and four (4) notches on the south face.
