## INSTRUMENT

This survey was made with a Buff and Berger transit,  
The courses were deflected from a true meridian as determined from a direct solar observation.

The distances were measured with a 500 ft. steel tape.

Note-; The disagreement of these field notes with the location certificates is due to errors in the latter.

## REPORT

All lines of this survey and all the lines and ties to contiguous surveys were made direct upon the ground.

The Sec. Cor. to Secs. 22, 23, 26 and 27 T. 13 N. R. 24 E. , M. D. B. and M. to which connection is given is a granite stone 12x10x10 ins. set in a mound of stone and earth, marked 2 notches on S. and 2 on E. face.

X The Sec Cor. To Secs. 26, 27, 34 and 35 T. 13 N. R. 24 E., M. D. B. and M., to which connection is given is a quartzite stone 12x10x8 ins. set in a mound of stone , marked, 1 notch on S. and 2 on E. face.

The  $\frac{1}{2}$ Sec. Cor. between Secs. 26 and 27, T. 13 N. R. 24E. M. D. B. and M. was not found I have therefore used the course and distance between the S. W. Cor. of Sec. 26 and the N. W. Cor. of Sec. 26 T. 13 N. R. 24 E. M. D. B. and M. , which I found to be N. 0° 19' 20" W. 5254.90 ft.

The corners on t he ground to which connection are given are described as follows;-

Cor. No. 1-1, Copper Queen No. 6, and Alcatraz lodes, (unsurveyed) is a pine post 4 ins. square showing 2 ft. above the ground in a mound of stone and earth, scribed S. E. Cor. C. Q. No 6, and S. W. Cor. A.

Cor. No. 2-4, Alcatraz and Copper Queen No. 2, lodes (unsurveyed) is a pine post 4 ins. square showing
