Other Improvements.

A stable, frame 12x24.5 ft., course of long sides N.27° 46'E. S.E.Cor.of stable bears from Cor.No.4 Gypsum lode S.44°30'W.571 ft. Said stable belongs to Claimant herein.

A granary, frame 12x14 ft., course of long sides N.23° 04'E. N.E.Cor.of granary bears from Cor.No.4 Gypsum lode S.43°W.603 ft. Said granary belongs to Claimant herein.

A bunk house, frame 14x20 ft., course of long sides S.88° 41'E. N.E.Cor.of bunk house bears from Cor.No.4 Gypsum lode S.26°W.954 ft. Said bunk house belongs to Claimant herein.

A pump house, 7½x12 ft., course of long sides N.28°29'E. The N.E.Cor.of pump house bears from Cor.No.4 Gypsum lode S.41°45'W.1040 ft. Said pump house belongs to Claimant herein.

Instrument.

This survey was made with a Berger No.4 Transit. The courses were deflected from the true Meridian as determined by a direct Solar observation.

The distances were measured with a 500 ft. steel tape.

Report.

Cor.to Secs.26, 27, 34 and 35, T.13 N., R.24 E., Mt.D.B. and M., is a quartzite stone 12x10x8 ins., marked with 1 notch on the South edge and 5 notches on the North edge.

Cor.No.1 Sur.No.3179 A, Gypsum South Extension lode is a pine post 4 ins.square, 2½ ft.above ground in mound of stones, scribed 1-3179-A

Cor.No.2 Sur.No.3179 A, Gypsum South Extension lode is a pine post 4 ins.square, 2½ ft. above ground in mound of stone, scribed 2-3179-A

Cor.No.9 Sur.No.2801 South Extension of Ludwig lode is a pine post 4x6 ins., 2½ ft.above ground in same mound
