

The fact that the section tie reported herein differs by several minutes from the tie obtained by traversing the section ties and boundary lines reported in the field notes of intervening approved surveys is due to errors in said intervening approved surveys. All lines of the following traverse were actually run upon the ground, in connection with this survey; Beginning at Cor. No. 1, Sur. No. 3683, Annette lode, thence S.44°09'W. 281.6 ft. to Cor. No. 5, 2nd Amd. Sur. No. 2605, Erie lode; thence S.47°31'W. 748.85 ft. to post, not scribed, bearing almost illegible pencil marks, but probably "W. Side Center" Georgetown lode, Sur. No. 2605 (whence post scribed 1-1-2605 bears S.47°42'W. 151.27 ft.); thence S.21°09'E. 1416.50 ft. to Cor. No. 1, Sur. No. 3030, Mondamin lode; thence S.86°34'E. 795.27 ft. to S. E. Cor. to Sec. 27, Tp. 28 S., R. 63 E., M.D.M.; thence N.15°00'W. 2150.0 ft. to Cor. No. 1, Sur. No. 3683, Annette lode, the place of beginning. Lines 1-2 and 8-1, Sur. No. 3030, Mondamin lode, and the tie from Cor. No. 1 of said Sur., to S. E. Cor. to Sec. 27, as reported in the approved field notes of Sur. No. 3030, differ from the bearings of said lines as determined upon the ground by 4'.

REPORT;--

The S. E. Cor. to Sec. 27, Tp. 28 S., R. 63 E., M.D.M., is a granite rock, 10x12 ins., standing about 14 ins. above ground. No chisel marks can be distinguished upon it, and it was only found and identified by re-running the tie reported from Cor. No. 1, Sur. No. 3030, Mondamin lode.

Cor. No. 3, 2nd Amd. Sur. No. 2605, Erie lode, Cor. Nos. 4 and 5, Sur. No. 2605, Georgetown lode, and 2nd Amd. Sur. No. 2605, Erie lode, respectively, and Cor. No. 1, Sur. No. 3030, Mondamin lode, to each of which connection is given, are pine posts, about 6 ft. long, 4 ins. square, showing 3 to 3 1/2 ft. above mounds of earth and stone, and scribed 4-2605, 5-4-2605, and 1-3030, respectively. The identity of each was established through personal inspection, by the scribings appearing thereon, and by comparison with plats of Sur. No. 2605 and 2nd Amd. Sur. No. 2605.

The following discrepancies exist between these field notes and the approved field notes of 2nd Amd. Sur. No. 2605:--

The courses and lengths of lines 3-4 and 4-5, 2nd Amd. Sur. No. 2605, Erie lode, as determined upon the ground are S.88°05'E. 682.0 ft., and S.44°09'W. 281.6 ft., respectively, instead of S.87°56'E. 682.83 ft., and S.44°44'W. 279.07 ft., respectively, as given in
