## Report

The South  $\frac{1}{4}$  Cor. Sec. 36 T. 5 S. R. 40 E. M. D. M. to which connection is herein given consists of a Limestone showing  $5 \times 11 \times 21$  ins. above ground chiselled  $\frac{1}{4}$ .

Cor. No. 3 Sec. No. 3682 Spider No. 1 lode consists of a post 4 ins. square showing  $2\frac{1}{2}$  ft. above ground sketched 3-3682.

Cor. No. 3 Sec. No. 3547 Capricorn lode consists of a stone showing  $6 \times 10 \times 18$  ins. above ground, chiselled 3-3547.
