Surrounding claims are all recent relocations, the boundaries and owners of which are unknown.

Report

The "4 Sec. Cor. Stone" to which Cor. No. 1 of this claim is tied, is a rhyolite rock $4 \times 8 \times 8$ ins., set slightly in ground, with mound of rock to the west and chiseled "4" on its west side.

Cor. No. 3 Survey No. 3710, ^{Mine} connection lode is a pine post 4×4 ins., showing 2 ft. above a substantial mound of stone and earth, scribed 3-3710 and marked "S. E. Cor. Connection lode".

The Cor. of Tps. 10 and 11 S., Rgs. 46 and 47 E., Mt. Diablo B. and M. is a rhyolite rock $6 \times 12 \times 18$ ins. set in ground with mound of stone to the south, chiseled \equiv on N. E. S. and W. sides, R. 47 E. on east side, R. 46 E. on west side, T. 10 S. on north side and T. 11 S. on its south side.
