The N.W.corner of Sec.19-T.19 N.-R.44 E. of the Mt. Diablo B.and M. is a granite stone 6x8 ins.showing 6.ins. above ground with 3 notches chiseled on the north side and 3 notches chiseled on the south side. This is the nearest standing corner of the public survey that can be found and identified.

Sur.No.3313 Sunset lode. Corners No.1, 2 and 3 are stone corners properly set and chiseled with the number of the corner and survey. I find all courses and distances to be correct as approved.

Sur.No.70. Semanthe lode. All of the corners of this survey are missing. The tie of Cor.No.3 Janey C.W. Fraction lode to Cor.No.3 Semanthe lode was obtained by a traverse through the lines and ties of Sur.No. 3689 Eclipse lst West Extension lode to Sur.No.70 Semanthe lode.

Sur.No. 3689 Eclipse 1st West Extension lode. All of the corners are pine posts properly set and scribed with the number of the corner and survey. I find all courses and distances to be correct as approved.

The amended location certificate of the Janey C.W.Fraction lode is in error as regards the length of line 4-1 and the same is given correctly in these field notes.
