

## Survey No. 3718 A and B

## Survey No. 3313 Hillside lode.

Cor. No. 1 is a granite stone 7/10/12 ins. above ground.  
 Cor. No. 2 is a granite stone 10/12/12 ins. above ground.  
 Cor's. No's. 3 and 4 are pine posts 4/4 ins. by 3 feet  
 above ground.  
 All corners are correctly marked with the proper corner  
 and survey number.

## Roosevelt lode, unsurveyed.

The N.W. and S.W. corners are mounds of stone 3 feet  
 in diameter by 2 feet high. The N.E. and S.E. corners  
 are pine posts 4/4 ins. by 3 feet above ground. All  
 markings are effaced but they were identified by resi-  
 dents of Austin, Nevada as being the corners of this lode.  
 The westerly end line is N 50°30'E 600 feet, the north-  
 erly side line is S 52°50'E 1430.8 feet. The easterly  
 end line is S 39°W 600 feet. The southerly side line  
 is N 52°15'W 1550 feet.

## Vulcan lode, unsurveyed.

All corners of this lode are pine posts, 4/4 ins. by 2  
 feet above ground. Set in the ground in mounds of earth  
 and stone. Properly marked with the name of the corner  
 and claim.

The end lines are N 44°E 600 feet and S 44°W 600 feet  
 respectively.

The side lines are N 46°W 1500 feet and S 46°E 1500  
 feet respectively.

3rd. The East  $\frac{1}{4}$  Cor. Sec. 24, T 19 N, R 43 E, Mt. Diablo  
 B. and M. is a granite stone, 12/12/10 ins. above ground.  
 Chiseled  $\frac{1}{4}$  on the west face.

## Note:

The discrepancy between these field notes and the  
 location certificate of the Pot Luck Extension lode  
 in regard to the length of lode line each way from the  
 location monument is due to errors in the latter.
