

## REPORT

- 1st The lines of these surveys and the connections to the corner of the public land survey were run upon the ground.
- 2nd Sur.No.118 Grand Prize lode Cor.No.3 is a pine post 3x4 ins.by 18 ins. above ground, set in the ground in a mound of earth and stone.  
Scribed Post 3 U.S.S.118. All other corners are missing.  
Annie Laurie lode, unsurveyed.  
The southerly end line is N 83° 24' W 600 feet, and the easterly side line is N9° 10' W 640 feet to the easterly side center.  
The southerly end posts and the easterly side center are pine posts 4x4 ins.by 2 feet above ground, properly marked with the name of the corner and claim.  
Noonday lode, unsurveyed.  
The end lines are N88° 41' E, 612 feet and the side lines are N13° 47' W, 1492.7 feet. All the corners are pine posts 4x4 ins. by 2½ feet above ground, properly marked with the name of the corner and claim.  
Silver Tip lode, unsurveyed.  
Line 1-2 is S50° 30' E, 930 feet  
Line 2-3 is S31° 30' E, 584.4 feet.  
Line 3-4 is N69° 30' E, 611.2 feet.  
Line 4-5 is N31° 30' W, 801.6 feet  
Line 5-6 is N50° 30' W 684 feet.  
Line 6-1 is S69° 30' W 692.8 feet  
All the corners are pine posts 4x4 ins.by 3 feet above ground properly marked with the name of the corner and claim.
- 3rd The N.E.Cor.Sec.25, T 19N, R 43 E Mt Diablo B. and M. is a granite stone 14x12x8 ins. above ground.  
Chiseled with 4 grooves on the north face and with 2 grooves on the south face.  
Diligent search for U.S. Mineral Monument No.2 was made but it could not be found.
