

Report.

The S.E. Cor. of Sec. 20, T. 39 N. R. 46 E., Mt. Diablo B. and M. is a porphyry stone 12x16x4 ins. above ground, marked with 4 notches on East edge and 2 notches on South edge.

Could not find any corner of the Public Land Survey nearer than the S.E. Cor. of Sec. 20, T. 39 N. R. 46 E., Mt. D. B. and M.

Note:-

The disagreements between these field notes and the location and Amended location certificates of the Banner lode with regard to the length of the lode line, Banner Fraction lode with regard to the length of the lode line and position of the discovery, Gift No. 1 lode with regard to the length of the lode line, Gold Crown lode with regard to the length of the lode line, Gift No. 2 lode with regard to the length of the lode line, Wedge lode with regard to the length of the lode line, Rabbit's Foot lode with regard to the length of the lode line, length of Westerly end line, and position of the discovery, Oversight Fraction lode with regard to the position of the discovery, are due to errors in the location and Amended location certificates.

Instrument

This survey was made with a Berger Transit. The courses were deflected from the meridian as determined by a direct solar observation. The distances were measured with a 300 ft. steel tape.
