

SURVEY NO. 3744.

The S. E. Cor. Sec. 20, T. 39 N. R. 46 E. Mt. D.B. & M. is a stone 6 x 12 x $\frac{1}{2}$ ins. above ground with 2 notches on the south and 4 notches on the east face. This is the nearest standing corner of the public survey that can be found and identified.

COLORADO GRANDE NO. 2 LODE UNSURVEYED.

The N.E., N.W., E.S.Center and S.E.Corners of the Colorado Grande No. 2 lode are 4 x 4 sawed pine posts 2-1/2 feet above ground firmly set in mound of stones, marked N.E.Cor. Colorado Grande No. 2 lode, N.W. Cor. Colorado Grande No. 2, E.S.Center Colorado Grande No. 2, and S.E.Cor. Colorado Grande No. 2.

COLORADO GRANDE NO. 3 LODE UNSURVEYED.

The S.E.; S.W. and East side center Corner posts of the Colorado Grande No. 3 lode are sawed pine posts 4 inches square 2-1/2 feet above ground, firmly set in mound of stones, marked S.E.Cor. Colorado Grande No. 3, S.W. Cor. Colorado Grande No. 3 and E.S.Center Colorado Grande No. 3 respectively.
