REPORT.

U.S.L.M. No.170, Is a pine post 6 ins. square, set on the summit of Bull Frog Mountain, showing 36 ins. above mound of stone 3 ft. high, 5 ft. base, scribed U.S.L.M. No.170, on the S.E. side.

Cor. No.1, Sur.No.2513, North Bull Frog lode is a pine post, 4 ins. square scribed 1-2513,

Cor.No.2, Sur.No.2294, Bull Frog Lode is a pine post 4 ins. square scribed 2-2294.

The S.E. corner of Sec. 12, T.12 S. R. 45 E. M.D.B. and M. is a stone showing 8x4x7 ins. above the ground chiseled two notches on the north side and four notches on the south side, Whence a mound of stone 2.5 ft. high, 3 ft. base bears west 3 ft.
