

Survey No. 3779.

A frame cabin 10 x 21 ft., the north-west corner of which bears S. 46° 55' E., 300 ft. from Cor.

No. 2, Gray Eagle Lode. Cabin bears S. 63° W.

A frame cabin 12 x 24 ft., the west corner of which bears S. 38° 50' E., 368 ft. from Cor. No.

2, Gray Eagle Lode. Cabin bears S. 48° W.

Cabins belong to claimants herein.

 INSTRUMENT.

The survey was made with a large Buff & Berger transit. The courses were deflected from the true meridian as determined by direct solar observation. The distances were measured with 300 and 100 foot steel tapes.

 REPORT.

✓ The nearest land corner I could find was the south 1/4 corner of Sec. 22, T. 18 N., R. 64 E., M.D.M. This is a limestone 7 x 8 ins. extending 11 ins. out of the ground surrounded by a large mound of stone and has "1/4" chiselled on the south side. To the east of this corner the land ascends rapidly on a steep slope and to the west extends out in open gravelly land covered with sage-brush.

 OTHER IMPROVEMENTS.

A frame cabin 14 x 18 ft., the north-west corner of which bears S. 23° 00' E., 287 ft. from Cor. No. 2, Gray Eagle Lode. Cabin bears S. 73° W.
