

of the lodes on the Fairview and Fairview No.1 lodes of this survey; and will be transmitted in a separate affidavit of expenditure.

Instrument.

This survey was made with an Ainsworth and Sons transit. The courses were deflected from the true meridian as determined by direct solar observations and checked by observations on Polaris.

The distances were measured with 12 ft. and 750 ft. steel tapes.

Report.

The boundary lines and the tie line to the Corner of the Public Survey were determined from lines run direct upon the ground.

The N. W. Cor. Sec. 34, T. 46 N., R 39 E. of the Mt. Diablo B. and M. is a volcanic stone, chiseled with 1 notch on the South face, and 3 notches on the East face.

I was unable to find the N. $\frac{1}{4}$ Cor. of said section, although I made a diligent search for the same.

These field notes show the position of the location monuments and the corner monuments as they existed on the ground at the time of this survey.
