

REPORT.

The W. 1/4 Cor. Sec.36, T. 31 N., R. 43 E., M.D.B. & M. is a porphyry stone 10x12 ins. showing 16 ins. above the ground, marked 1/4 on the west side. A mound of rock 4 ft. in dia. at base, 3½ ft. high, bears S.70°E. 12 ft. Cors. No.2-3-4-1, Sur.No.2202 Moscow lode, Cors.No.1-2-3-4-5, William lode, unsurveyed, are all pine posts showing two ft. above ground and scribed with their respective corner number and name of claim.

Cors.No.1-2-3-4, South Monitor lode, unsurveyed, are rock monuments 3½ ft. base, and 3 ft. high marked with their respective corner number and name of claim.

Cor.No.3, Sur.No.1844, East Lake Superior lode, is a pine post showing two ft. above ground and scribed with its respective corner number and name of claim.

I find line 3-4 Sur.No.2202 Moscow lode to be S.3°06'E. 1501.7 ft., and line 4-1 of the same lode and survey to be N.86°51'30"E. 600.00 ft. The tie from Cor.No.1, Sur. No.2202, Moscow lode is S.59°36'40"E. 6278.64 ft.
