## INSTRUMENT.

This survey was made with a Dietzgen light mountain transit. The courses were deflected from the true meridian as determined by direct solar observations.

The distances were measured with a 660 ft. steel tape.

NOTE: - The disagreements between these field notes and the amended location certificate of the Hillside No. 3 lode, are due to errors in the latter.

## REPORT.

The S.E. Cor. of Sec. 1, T.7 S., R.41 E., Mt. Diablo B. and M. is a stone 8x8 ins. 6 ins. high, marked with 1 groove on the north and 5 grooves on the south sides.
