

SURVEY NO. 3862.

Shaft No. 2 and Tunnel No. 1 are common improvements to the Exchange, Exchange No. 1, Exchange No. 2 and Exchange No. 3 lodes, these lodes have, in my opinion, been advantageously developed by said improvements, and 1/4 of their value has been credited to each of these claims.

INSTRUMENT.

This survey was made with a C. L. Berger and Son's mining transit No. 6253. The courses were deflected from the true meridian as determined by direct solar observations. The distances were measured with a 500 ft. steel tape.

REPORT.

The lines of this survey and all tie lines were run upon the ground.

The corner to Sections 27, 28, 33 and 34, T. 18 N., R. 64 E., Mt. Diablo B. and M., is a limestone, 8x10x18 ins. high, chiseled 3 notches on the East and 1 on the South face. This is the nearest standing corner of the public land survey that can be found and identified.
