Transit. The courses were deflected from the true meridian as determined by direct solar observation. The distances were measured with 650 and 100 ft. steel tapes.

Report.

The Section Corner at S.E. Cor. Sec. 17, T.1, N.R.67 E., M.D.B. & M. was a 1x1 in. stake in a small pile of rocks.

All marks were obliterated but the corner was identified by ties from previous official surveys.

All corners of conflicting and adjoining surveys mentioned in body of notes were found in place and properly scribed.

The discrepancies between the returns of these lodes and their respective location certificates are due to errors in the latter.
