INSTRUMENT.

This survey was made with a Berger transit. The courses were deflected from the true Meridian as determined by direct solar observations. Distances were measured with a 500 ft. steel tape.

REPORT.

The N. W. Cor. Sec. 35, T. 3 N. R 42 E., M. D. M., is a porphyry stone 6X8 ins. 8 ins above ground marked I notch on the south and 2 notches on the East face.
