FEET.

No.1 lode. Course of longer side N.89° E.

A bunk house and office, size 12x14 ft. the N. W. Cor. of which bears S.30°05'E. 604.4 ft. from Cor. No.2 Copper Hill No. 1 lode. Course of longer side N.89° E.

A wagon road has been built to the property from the Railroad Station at Luning, a distance of about 12 miles.

#### I N S T R U M E N T.

This survey was made with a Berger Mining Transit, No.5107. The courses were deflected from a true Meridian, determined by direct solar observation. The distances were measured with a 660 ft. steel tape.

#### R E P O R T.

The S. W. Cor. of Sec. 32, T. 9 N., R. 33 E. M.D.M. is a diorite stone 6x6x14 ins. set in a mound of stone and marked with one notch on the west, and five notches on the east edges respectively. This is the nearest corner of the public land surveys I could find near the property.

The location corners of the several locations are split redwood tiles, averaging 4 ins. in least dimensions. These were replaced by 4x4 ins. square posts, planed and scribed as described in these notes, where the location was identical with the survey.
