R. 53 E. M.D.B. and M. bears S. 59°-50' E. 565.1 ft. a cottonwood tree 5 ins. in diameter bears S. 84°-15' E. 49 ft. dist.

No. 2, 1-3896, whence the 1/4 Cor. on S. line of Sec. 36, Tp. 38 N. R. 53 E. M.D.B. and M. bears S. 60°-47' E. 581.5 ft., a cottonwood tree 4 ins. in diameter bears N. 20°-W. 30 ft. blazed and scribed, B.T. U.S.S. 3896.
