

## Survey 3896 Cont'd

Feet

from a point on line I-2 Ajax lode, S.88°-30' W. 295 ft.  
from Cor. No.1, tunnel 4X6 ft. running S. 67°-W. 25 ft.  
to face, cut runs N. 60°-E. 20 ft.

Value of cut and tunnel \$125.00

No.1. The discovery cut and tunnel of the Floradora No.2  
lode, the mouth of tunnel bears from location point N. 1°-  
30'W. 20 ft., 4-1/2 X 7 ft. running W. 24 ft. to face.  
From mouth of tunnel a cut 4-1/2 ft. wide runs east 20 ft.

No.2. From location point an incline shaft bears N. 20°-W.  
50 ft. Dip 55°-W. 4-1/2 ft. X 6 ft. timbered 40 ft., 73 ft.  
deep.

Value \$730.00

No.1. The discovery shaft of the Floradora No.1. lode on  
lode line at location stake 4ft X 6ft. X 10ft. deep.

Value \$40.00

No.2. A tunnel 53 ft. long 4-1/2 ft. X 7 ft. in hard rock,  
A cut at the mouth of same 4-1/2 ft. wide 19 ft. long bears  
S. 46°-II'E., tunnel N.46°-II'W., the mouth of said tunnel  
bears from Cor. No.2. N.46°-II'W. 281.4 ft.

No.3. From location point a cut 4ft. X 13ft. bears S.  
9°-W. 70ft. Course of cut N. 55°-W.

## OTHER IMPROVEMENTS.

A lumber house, the S.W. Cor. of which bears from South  
side center of Floradora No.1 lode., N. 1°-E. 180 ft.  
Course of long side N. 57°-E. 12 x 24 ft.

## Instrument.

This survey was made with a W. and L.E. Gurley transit.  
The courses were all deflected from the true meridian as  
determined by direct observation on Polaris, at eastern  
elongation and the true meridian staked on east side line  
of Floradora No.2 lode. The distances were measured with  
300 ft. steel tape.

## REPORT.

The lines of each location of this survey were run directly  
from Cor. to Cor. wherever accessible and where not access-  
ible at off-sets therefrom. All tie lines were run either  
directly upon the ground or by traverses run upon the ground  
and submitted in a separate report herewith.

The 1/4 Cor. on Tp. line between 37 and 38 N., R. 53 E.  
M.D.B. and M., also on line between Sec. I and 36 is a granite  
stone 16x8x6 ins. in a mound of stone 2-1/2 ft. base, 1-1/2  
ft. high, marked 1/4 on N. face. To this 1/4 Cor. all tie  
lines from Cor. No.1 is given. The Cor. common to Secs.  
I-2-35-36 Tps. 37 and 38 N., R. 53 E. M.D.B. and M. is a  
granite stone 3x8 ins. 18 ins. long set in the ground with  
small mound of stone around it chiseled 1 on E. face 5 on  
W. face 22 ft. short of Dist. S.W. Cor. Hylton lode un-  
surveyed is a pine post 4x4 ins. square in substantial mound  
of stone marked S.W. Cor. Hylton.

All corners of this survey are pine posts properly set and  
scribed with the number of the Cor. and survey.
