

## Survey No. 3907.

## Instrument.

This survey was made with a C.L. Berger and Sons Mining Transit.

The courses were deflected from the true meridian as determined by direct solar observations.

The distances were measured with 100 ft. and 600 ft. steel tapes.

## Report.

The Cor. to Secs. 2 and 3 on North Bdy. T.8 S., R.42 E., M.D.B. and M. is a rhyolite stone 12x8x8 ins. above ground chiseled with 2 notches on east and 4 notches on west edges, with mound of stone west of Cor.

Cor. No. 1. Sur. No. 3502 A. New Century lode is a pine post 4x4 ins., extending 2 ft. above a mound of earth and stone scribed 1-3502 A.

## Other Improvements.

An open cut, tunnel and drift; north of cut bears from Cor. No. 1 N. 32° 25' W. 298.0 ft. from north, cut runs S. 30° W. 31 ft. to face 3x8 ft., from base of cut, Tunnel 3x8 ft. runs S. 30° W. 67 ft. to point 1, thence S. 5° W. 8 ft. to present. From point 1 a drift 3x8 ft. runs N. 87° E. 10 ft. to present. From point 1 a drift runs west 84 ft. to where 3x8 ft., 12 ft. deep, drift continues west 19 ft. further to point 2, thence S. 22° W. 39 ft. to beginning of work applied upon this claim.

A shaft 4x8 ft., 41 ft. deep, connecting with drift described above, the center of which bears from Cor. No.
