

INSTRUMENT.

This survey was made with an C,L.Berger mining transit No.3246. The distances were measured with 100-ft. and 660-ft. steel tapes. The courses were deflected from the true meridian as determined by an observation on Polaris at eastern elongation.

REPORT.

The W.1/4 Cor.Sec. 36, T.31 N, R.43 E, M.D.M. is a porphyry stone 10 X 12 ins. showing 16 ins. above the ground, marked 1/4 on the west side. A mound of rock 4 ft. high, 4 ft. in diameter at base, bears S 70°E 12 ft.

✓ Sur.No.3842 Daisy lode:

Corners 2 and 3 are pine posts , properly set and scribed with the number of the corner and survey.

Sur.No.2202 Moscow lode:

Corners 1,3 and 4 are pine posts, properly set and scribed with the number of the corner and survey. I find line 3-4 to be S3°06'E 1501.7 ft. and line 4-1 to be N 86°51' 30"E 600. ft. and the tie from Cor.No.1 Sur.No.2202, Moscow lode, to the W.1/4 Cor.Sec. 36, T.31 N, R.43 E, M.D.M. to be S 59°36'40"E 6278.64 ft.
