

Report.

The lode line of this location was run directly on the ground, and the several corners established by means of offsets from the lode line.

The S.E. Cor. of Sec. 36 is the Township Cor. for Townships 8 and 9 N. R 32-33 E. M. D. B. and M. It is a limestone rock, 6"x6", set in mound of rock, exposed for 8 inches. Chiseled ||||| on the N. E. S. and W. sides.

The mound of rock is 2 ft. high, 4 ft. base, diligent search failed to find any nearer corner of the public survey.

The location monument is of rock, 4.5 ft. high, 4 ft. base. In it was a can, which contained the location notice.

The N.E. Cor. of the location is a fine post 4 in. square, set in mound of rock, and exposed for 6 ft. On it was written "N.E. Cor. Silver Reef lode".

The location corners for Cors 2-3-4 were not found, but the S.E. end center was found at $S 66^{\circ} 48' E$ 194.93 ft. from the center of the S.E. end line.

The S.E. end center is a monument of rock 4.5 ft. base, 5 ft. high, in which was a paper marked "S.E. end center Silver Reef lode".

I have taken the acknowledgement of the Assistant for the reason that there is not a Notary Public within twenty five miles, and two days would be consumed, and considerable expenses incurred in going to him.
