The S.E. Cor of sec 36 is the Township Cor. for Townships 8 and 9 N. R. 32 E. M. D. B and M.

It is a limestone rock ~~6 in x 6 in~~ set in mound of rock, exposed for 8 ins. Chiseled ||||| on the N.-E.-S. and W. sides. The mound of rock is 2 ft. high, 4 ft. base.

Diligent search failed to find any nearer corner of the public survey. Therefore in establishing the intersections of the section lines with the various boundary lines of this survey and the points for the sec. and $\frac{1}{4}$ Cor. I was compelled to take the notes of the public survey.

The location monuments of the respective lodes of this survey are of rock 4.5 ft. high, 4 ft. base. In each was a tin can containing the location notice of the respective lode.

The S.E. Cor. of the Moss Copper location was a monument of rock 4.5 ft. high, 4 ft. base. In which was a paper, marked "S.E. Cor. Moss Copper".

The N.E. Cor. of the Moss Copper location and the S.E. Cor. of the Camp View location was a common monument of rock 3.5 ft. high, 3.5 ft. base, in which was a paper marked "N.E. Cor. of the Moss Copper and S.E. Cor. of the Camp View".

The E. side center of the Moss Copper was a monument of rock 4 ft. high, 2.5 ft. base, in which was a paper marked "E. side center of the Moss Copper".
