Instrument.

This survey was made with a Berger transit. The courses were deflected from the true meridian as determined by solar observation.

Distances were measured with a 500 ft. steel tape.

NOTE:-The disagreements between these field notes and the location certificate of this claim is due to errors in the latter.

Report.

The N. E. Cor. Sec. 24, T. 6. N. R. 49 E., M.D.M., is a granite stone 9x14 ins. 8 ins. above ground, marked with 3 notches on the South and 3 notches on the North face.

Cor. No. 4 Sur. No. 38 Crosby Lode is a post 4 ins. square standing 3 ft. above mound of rock scribed 4-38

Line 1-2 Sur. No. 43 Bunker Hill Lode is S. 38° 54' W. 300.8 ft. instead of S. 39° 15' W., 300 ft.

Line 3-4 Sur. No. 38 Crosby Lode is N. 27° 19' E., 429 ft. instead of N. 27° 45' E., 400 ft.

Bearing of line 4-1 Sur. No. 38 Crosby Lode is S. 62° 39' E., instead of S. 62°15' E.

Tie from Cor. No. 1 Sur. No. 43 Bunker Hill Lode to Cor. No. 4, Sur. No. 38 Crosby Lode, is S, 26° 58' E., 217.1 ft., instead of S. 19° 46' E., 237 feet.
