REPORT.

I found the N.W. Cor. of Sec. 4, T. 30 N., R. 24 E. M.D. B. and M. to be properly marked and witnessed as in the field notes of survey of West boundary of said section, by a stone 9 x 24 inches in a small mound of rocks.

I found no workings nor monuments of any kind upon this claim except the workings placed thereon by the claimant and his grantors.

Survey No. 3602, Selenite Placer. All corners are pine posts, properly set and scribed with the number of the corner and survey. I find lines 1-2 and 4-1 to be correct

as approved.

There are no ledges or indications of mineral of any nature except gypsum upon the ground embraced in this claim.

OTHER IMPROVEMENTS

There are no other improvements.

INSTRUMENTS

This survey was made with an A. Field light mountain and leveling transit. The courses were deflected from the true meridian as determined by an observation on Polaris. The distances were measured with a 500 and a 50 ft. steel tape.
