This survey was made with a Berger transit. The courses were deflected from the true Meridian as determined by solar observation.

Distances were measured with a 500 ft. steel tape.

The N. E. Cor. Sec. 24 T. 6 N. R. 49 E., M.D.M., is a granite stone 9x14 ins. 8 ins. above ground, marked with 3 notches on the south and 3 notches on the north face.

Cor. No. 4 Sur. No. 3948 Garrett Lode and Cor. No. 2 Sur. No. 37 Two G Lode, is a pine post, marked 2-37, G 4-3948.

Cor. No. 4 Sur. No. 42 Mill Site, is a post marked 4-42.
