

SURVEY NO. 3962.

At the 100 ft. Level in Shaft under Imp. No. 11, there is 286. ft. of Drifting, 4 x 6 ft., one 108 ft long, running northeasterly. At a point 30 ft from Shaft a Drift runs northwesterly 30.5 ft. One 92 ft. long running southwesterly. At a point 25 ft. from Shaft a Drift runs southeasterly 55.5 ft.

All the property of claimants herein and are applied as improvements upon no other claims.

INSTRUMENT.

This survey was made with a Buff and Buff Light Mountain Transit. The courses were deflected from the true meridian as determined by observation upon the sun. The distances were measured with 100 and 500 ft. steel tapes.

REPORT.

The N. W. Cor. Sec. 1, T. 5 S., R. 46 E., M. D. B. and M. is a rock 6 x 12 x 13 ins. above ground, chiseled with 5 notches on the W. and 1 notch on the east faces.
