Instrument

This survey was made with an A. Lietz Co. light mountain transit; The courses were deflected from the true meridian as determined by observation on polaris.

The distances were measured with 100-ft and 500-ft. steel tapes

Report

The S. W. cor. of Sec. 36 T. 4 S., R. 46 E. M. D. B. and M. is a rock 3×12 ins. 14 ins above the ground, chiseled five notches on the west, one notch on the east and S. C. on the north

Survey No. 3962, Daisy, Mohawk and Last chance Lodes:

corners 4 and 1 Daisy Lode, corner No. 2 Daisy Lode, identical with corner No. 1 Mohawk Lode, corner No. 2 Mohawk Lode, identical with corner No. 1 Last chance Lode and corner No. 2 Last chance Lode are pine post, properly set and scribed with the initials of name of lodes, number of corner and survey

all location corners of this survey were pine posts, found in place and properly marked
