location, and that said improvements consist of:

- No. 1. A shaft 5x7 ft. 27 ft. deep in rock. Shaft bears from Cor. No. 4 Annie Fraction No. 1 lode N.66° 59' E. 1373.9 ft.
Value of shaft.....\$405.00
- No. 2. A shaft 5-1/2x8 ft. 100 ft. deep in rock. Shaft is well timbered. Mouth of shaft bears from Cor. No. 4 Annie Fraction No. 1 lode N. 74° 55' E. 1073.0 ft.
Value of shaft.....\$1800.00

The surface embraced in this claim rises rapidly in a northeasterly and southwesterly direction from the shaft described as improvement No. 2.

The two shafts described above tend towards the development of the Ratler and Montie Cristo lodes, Sur. No. 2998, as well as the two lodes of this claim. Therefore an undivided 1/4 interest in the two shafts is credited to each of said four lodes.

Other Improvements.

There are none.

Instrument.

This survey was made with a Berger No. 4 Transit. The courses were deflected from the true meridian as determined by a direct solar observation.

The distances were measured with a 650 ft. steel tape.

REPORT.

The Cor. to Secs. 5,6,7 and 8, T. 16 N., R. 63 E., Mt. D. B. & M. is a limestone, 4x4x5 ins. above ground, marked with 5 notches on S. and E. edges.
