TRACT "C".

Beginning at Cor. No. 4, Hawkeye lode, of this survey, Thence S. 53° 38' E., 582.11 ft., along line 4-1, Hawkeye lode, to a point on line 2-3, Sur. No. 3627, Colorado lode, 531.97 ft. from Cor.
