OTHER IMPROVEMENTS.

None.

INSTRUMENT.

This survey was made with a C. L. Berger mining transit No. 7253. The courses were deflected from the true meridian as determined by direct solar observations. The distances were measured with a 650 ft. steel tape.

REPORT.

The lines of this survey and the tie lines were run upon the ground.

The NW. Cor. of Sec. 34, T. 17 N., R. 64 E., Mt. Diablo B. and M. is a quartzite stone, 8x10 ins., 6 ins. above ground in a mound of stone, not marked. This is the nearest standing corner of the public survey that can be found and identified.

The 1/4 Sec. Cor. between Secs. 29 and 32, T. 17 N., R. 64 E., Mt. Diablo B. and M., is a cedar stake 1 in. in diameter, 2 ft. long in a mound of earth, marked "1/4" on the north face.
