Instrument

This survey was made with a Buff and Buff Light Mountain Transit. The courses were deflected from the true meridian as determined by direct solar observations. The distances were measured with 650 and 100 ft. steel tapes.

Report

The N. $\frac{1}{4}$ Cor. Sec. 22 is a 6x6 post extending 4 ft. above the ground marked $\frac{1}{4}$ cor. sec. 22 on south face and $\frac{1}{4}$ cor. sec. 15 on north face. Just north is a ^{limestone} rock 8x6x18 scribed $\frac{1}{4}$ on upper face.

Survey No 3869 Hy Spy Lode.

All corners of this claim are 4x4 sawed pine posts firmly set and properly scribed.

Survey No 3869 Hy Spy No 3 Lode.

All corners of this claim are 4x4 sawed pine posts firmly set and properly marked.

The S.W. Cor. Sec. 22 T. 18 N. R. 64 E. Mt. Diablo Band 770. is a limestone rock 4x10x14 inches high in a mound of stone. Chiseled with 3 notches on E. face and 2 on S face.
