Inez Lode

A tunnel the mouth of which bears from Cor.No.4,
N.4°42'E.290.00 ft.,course of tunnel S.78°W.,4×6×160 ft.
long.

INSTRUMENT

This survey was made with a Buff and Buff Mining Transit
No.3850. The courses were deflected from the true meridian
as determined by an observation on Polaris. The distances
were measuerd with 500 and 50 ft.steel tapes.

REPORT

The lode line was calculated by a tie from Cor.No.2 to
the location notice.

The W.1/4 corner of Section 28,T.20 N.,R.20 E.,M.D.M.,
is a stone 12×4 inches,projecting 10 inches above ground,
chiseled 1/4 on west face,with mound of rock.

Cor.No.1, Sur.No.4040 Anna Bell Lode,is a porphyry stone,
10×8×inches,projecting 10 inches above ground,chiseled
A B 1-4040,with + on top,and witnessed by a mound of stone.

Cor.No.2 Sur.No.1949 is a porphyry stone,4×6 inches,
chiseled USS 2-1949,projecting 10 inches above ground,and
witnessed by a mound of stone.
