This survey was made with a C.L.Berger Mining Transit No. 3246. The courses were deflected from the true meridian as determined by an observation on Polaris at eastern elongation. The distances were measured with 100-ft. and 660-ft. steel tapes.

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Report.

The S.W.Cor.Sec.34, T.46 N, R.58 E, M.D.M. is a quartz stone, 6 X 7 X 12 ins., with a mound of rock surrounding, and chiseled with 2 notches on the east side and 4 notches on the west side.

All lines of this survey were run upon the ground.
