I hereby certify that the value of the labor and improvements upon this claim, placed thereon by the claimant or its grantors is not less than five hundred dollars, and that said improvements consist of :-

- No.1. Discovery cut, northerly end of which bears from Cor. No. 5, S 40° E., 50 ft., 5 ft. wide, 6 ft. deep, running S 40° E., 80 ft. to southerly end.
Value \$340.00.
- No.2. Cut, northerly end of which bears from Cor. No. 5, N 88° E., 53 ft., 5 ft. wide, 2.5 ft. deep, running S 42° E., 40 ft. to southerly end.
Value \$70.00.
- No.3. Cut, westerly end of which bears from Cor. No. 5, S 55° E., 168 ft., 6 ft. wide, 6 ft. deep, running N 49° E., 14 ft. to easterly end.
Value \$70.00.
- No.4. Shaft, which bears from Cor. No. 1, S 70° 15' W., 52 ft., 4X6 ft. 20 ft. deep, partly timbered.
Value \$400.00.

OTHER IMPROVEMENTS.

Shaft, which bears from Cor. No. 5, S 41° E., 144 ft., 10X10 ft. 10 ft. deep, claimant unknown.

INSTRUMENT.

This survey was made with a Berger transit. The courses were deflected from the true meridian, as determined by direct solar observations. Distances were measured with a 500 ft. steel tape.

NOTE:- The disagreements between these field notes and the amended location certificate of this claim are due to errors in the latter.
