

Cut, southerly end of which bears from Cor. No. 1,
Sunrise Lode, N 54° 45' E., 170 ft., 4 ft. wide, 4 ft.
deep, running N 25° W., 45 ft. to northerly end, claimant
unknown.

Cut, southerly end of which bears from Cor. No. 1,
Sunrise Lode, N 39° 45' E., 185 ft., 4 ft. wide, 4 ft.
deep, running N 30° W., 85 ft. to northerly end, claimant
unknown.

Cut, southerly end of which bears from Cor. No. 1,
Sunrise Lode, N 39° 45' E., 235 ft., 5 ft. wide, 5 ft.
deep, running N 45° E., 40 ft. to northerly end,
claimant unknown.

INSTRUMENT.

This survey was made with a Berger transit. The courses
were deflected from the true meridian, as determined by
direct solar observations. Distances were measured with
a 500 ft. steel tape.

NOTE:- The disagreements between these field notes and
the amended location certificates of the lodes in this
claim, are due to errors in the latter.
