

This survey was made with a C. L. Berger Mining Transit
 No. 3246. The courses were deflected from the true merid-
 ian as determined by an observation on Polaris at eastern
 Elongation. The distances were measured with 100-ft. and
 660-ft. steel tapes.

REPORT.

The N.1/4 Cor. Sec. 4, T. 29 N, R. 46 E, M.D.M. is a
 quartzite rock, 9 X 16 X 24 ins., with mound of rock
 surrounding and chiseled with 1/4 on the north side.

Sur. No. 3640, Carnation No. 1 lode:

ms Corners 1, 2, and 4 are pine post, properly set and
 described with the number of the corner and survey.

Survey No. 4086, White Rock, Hill Top No. 2, Independence
 Strike No. 3 and Cloro lodes:

All of the corners are pine posts properly set and
 described with the number of the corner and survey.

The intersections with *Lot 4*, Sec. 4
 were calculated from a traverse run upon the ground and
 submitted in a separate report herewith.
