INSTRUMENT.

This survey was made with a Berger transit. The
courses were deflected from the true meridian, as
determined by direct solar observations. Distances were
measured with a 500 ft. steel tape.

NOTE:- The disagreements between these field notes and
the amended location certificates of the lodes in this
claim are due to errors in the latter.

REPORT.

The 1/4 Sec. Cor. on the East Boundary of Sec. 26,
T 3 N., R 42 E., M.D.B. and M., is a stone 8X8 ins.,
standing 10 ins. above ground, chiseled 1/4 on the
north face.

Cor. No. 5, Sur. No. 2350, Black Diamond Lode, is a
post scribed 5-2350.

Cors. No. 4, Sur. No. 3359, Defender and Columbia
Lodes, is a post, scribed 4-4-3359.

Cors. No. 4, Little Tonopah and Little Tonopah No. 1
Lodes, and Cor. No. 2, Sur. No. 2075, Gronje Lode, are
posts, scribed with the number of the corner and the
survey.

Cor. No. 6, Sur. No. 2171, Silver Top Lode, is a
post, scribed 6-2171.

Cor. No. 5, Sur. No. 2178, Black Mascot Lode, is a
post, scribed 5-2178, 4-3880.
