

Report:

The N E Cor. Sec. 2, T 3 S., R 42 E is a Rock
6 x 9 ins., 9 ins. above ground chiseled with 1 notch
on East and 5 notches on West faces and cross on top.

Cor. No. 4 Survey No. 2844 Fraction Lode is a pine post
properly set and scribed with number of the corner and
survey.

I find the line 4-1 Sur. No. 2844 Omega to be N. 12°
52' W. instead of N. 12° 52' 30" W. as shown in the
approved notes.

No. 2 Discovery shaft 4 x 6 x 10 feet deep in earth and
rock, course of which bears from discovery post N 12° E
11 feet.

No. 3 A crosscut 4.5 x 6 from the bottom of above shaft
bears S 23° 45' E 10.5 feet.
Value \$ 50.00

No. 4 An open cut 3 x 3 face in earth, the mouth of which
bears S 42° 30' W 60 feet from Cor. No. 1 of this survey;
from mouth the cut runs S 39° E 18 feet to face.
Value \$ 50.00

This survey was made with a Eugene Stangen
Mountain and Mining Transit. The courses were deflected
from the true meridian as determined by observation upon
the sun.
The distances were measured with 100 ft. and 300 ft.
steel tapes.
