

FINAL OATHS FOR SURVEYS

INSTRUMENTS.

This survey was made with Lietz transit No.1349, the distances were measured with 100 and 660 ft. standard Lufkin steel tapes. The courses were deflected from the true meridian as determined from a direct solar observation.

NOTE:- The disagreements between the field notes and the location certificates of the Fortunatus and Prout lodes as to the courses of the boundary and lode lines, are due to errors in the latter.

REPORT.

All lines of these surveys of the Fortunatus and Prout lodes and the tie lines between the same and the tie to the Cor. to Secs. 25, 26, 35 and 36, T. 5 S., R. 39 E., Mt. Diablo B. and M., were made direct upon the ground.

The Cor. to Secs. 25, 26, 35 and 36, T. 5 S., R. 39 E., Mt. Diablo B. and M. is a granite stone showing 8 ins. above the surface of the ground marked with 1 notch on S. and 1 notch on E. edges. After diligent search this is the nearest corner of the public survey that could be found with reference to any of the corners of this survey.
