No.2

An open cut, the center of entrance to which bears from a point on line 3-4, this survey, at N.0°36'E. 750.00 ft. from Cor. No3, S.81°10'E. 236.6 ft. 4 ft.wide 10 ft. face, extending East 12 ft. to face. From the face is a tunnel 4 ft. wide, 6ft high, extending East 42.2 ft. to face. From a point in this tunnel 36.4 ft. from the entrance is a drift 4 ft. wide 6 ft. high extending North 29.8 ft. to face..... Value...\$745.00

No.3
