

Thence in an easterly direction 2300 ft.
to company buildings between tunnels
No. 3 and 4 on Camp Bird No. 4 lode.

Instrument

This survey was made with
a C. L. Berger and Sons transit
The courses were deflected from the
true meridian as determined by
direct solar observations.

The distances were measured with
700 ft. and 100 ft. steel tapes.

Report

All lines and ties of this
survey were run direct or by
traverse upon the ground.

The S. E. cor. of Sec. 13, Twp.
31 N. R. 33 E. M. D B & M. is
a stone 1 foot square well set
and showing 14 ins. above
ground. Chiseled III on north
face and III on south face
and C. C. on the west face.

This is the nearest standing
corner of the public survey which
can be found and identified.

The corners of Twp No. 39
Midas lode could not be found
and identified. The discovery
shaft, however, was identified
by common report and the topography
of the country. Work was in
progress at the Midas shaft while
this survey was being made. The
