

Survey No. 4140.

Report.

The Cor. to Secs. 32 and 33 on the South Bdy. T.7 S., R.42 E. is a granite rock 6 x 8 x 9 ins. above ground, Notches rather indefinite, with small mound of stone West of Corner.

The Cor. to Secs. 33 and 34 on the South Bdy. T.7 S., R.42 E. is a limestone 7 x 8 x 12 ins. above ground, chiseled with 3 notches on the East and 3 notches on the West edges; with mound of stone West of Corner.

Cor. No. 3, Sur. No. 2836 *Side Hill* lode, is a pine post 4 x 4 ins., extending 2.5 ft. above a mound of earth and stone, scribed 3 - 2836.

Note.

Because of the indefinite markings upon the stone at the S.W. Cor. of Sec. 33, I have run careful traverse and give the result, a direct tie, to the S.E. Cor. of said Sec. 33, T.7 S., R.42 E.

Errors.

I find the course and distance upon the South boundary of Sec. 33, T.7 S., R.42 E. to be N.89°57'W. 5271.0 ft. instead of West 5280.0 ft. as returned in Land Survey.
